

## Advice to my dear Hifz Students

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- **The Best:** In the Hadeeth we find, “The best among you are those who learn the Qur’an and teach it” (Bukhari). So count yourselves fortunate and make the most of this great blessing of becoming a Hafiz of the Glorious Qur’an
- **Use this opportunity** of becoming a hafiz as a means to attain the highest rank in Jannah where you will get everything you want
- **Remain sincere:** Our hifzul Qur’an is for Allah Ta’ala alone. Not for anyone else.
- **Concentration is key:** All distractions should be set aside when sitting to read. Anything which comes in the way of hifz should be removed; permanently if necessary.
- **Self discipline:** Parents and teachers are there to support your hifz. They will try, but ultimately you are responsible for your learning and hifz progress.

**Remember, hifzul Qur’an is something you have been chosen for by Allah Ta’ala so carry this responsibility with you at all times.**

- **There will be times** memorisation is hard. As long as you remain patient and keep trying. It will get easier.
- **Timetable:** Follow a good daily timetable, which includes adequate sleep, sufficient time for learning, helping out at home and spending time with family.
- **Healthy:** Eat healthy and eat foods which are good for your body and mind. Drink plenty of water and keep your body active.
- **Electronic:** Limit your time and access to electronics as this will not allow you the freedom you require to memorise.
- **Disobedience:** Stay away from the disobedience to Allah Ta’ala. Remember you have been chosen for a very special task and thus your actions should reflect this. Also sins are a huge obstacle in memorising and keeping the Qur’an to memory.
- **Advice:** Take and follow the advice of your parents and teachers. It is for your good.
- **Dua:** Make dua and take the dua of your parents and teachers through good behaviour and being dutiful to them. Remember without the help of Allah nothing is possible.
- **Finally** Hifz of the Glorious Qur’an is only the first step in your quest for knowledge. **Keep good intentions to study further after completing hifz by becoming an Aalim and serving the deen of Allah Ta’ala for which you have already been chosen for.**
